Exciting transformation commences at the former East Greenwood Primary School site

Perth – 19 December 2016 – Site works will soon commence on an innovative project to create a range of contemporary housing choices on the site of the former East Greenwood Primary School.

Leading property group, Frasers Property Australia (formerly known as Australand), is developing the infill project known as 'East Green' in partnership with the Housing Authority, as part of the State Government's commitment to roll out affordable housing options across the metropolitan area.

Acting Premier, Liza Harvey, and Housing Minister, Brendon Grylls, commemorated the start of site works at East Green last Wednesday, 14 December, by officially turning the first sod of soil.

Frasers Property Australia General Manager Residential WA, Tony Perrin, said future residents will have a choice of modern turnkey housing options not readily found in Greenwood or its surrounding suburbs, including architecturally-designed single and double storey homes and three storey apartment buildings.

"We are creating a variety of one, two and three bedroom homes, and one and two bedroom apartments to ensure the new East Green residential hub caters for every stage of life from first home buyers through to retirees," he said.

"There's a real focus on creating a truly connected community through clever streetscapes, pedestrian-friendly design elements, recreational spaces and overall aesthetics that will seamlessly blend the development with the existing suburb."

Mr Perrin said more than 25 per cent of the project site will be public open space meticulously planned to interface with 60 per cent of the homes being built.

"Homes will be low maintenance to deliver lower ongoing costs and more time for people to enjoy life."

The majority of homes will be Green Title with the exception of six lots featuring two homes on a Built Strata arrangement, and all apartments will have their own strata schemes.

Mr Perrin said the Frasers Property team was committed to helping the local community achieve its vision for the new East Green project to achieve a 5 Star Green Star rating under the widely recognised Green Building Council of Australia Communities Assessment program.

"A lot of work is going into planning and collaboration to enable this new community to raise the bar when it comes to the key elements of liveability, innovation, economic prosperity, governance and the environment.



“We believe this project will be a benchmark in residential development and one that the entire community can be justifiably proud of,” he said.

With its prime position within an established community and its convenient connection to the Perth CBD via Wanneroo Road and Mitchell Freeway, East Green will deliver a sought-after location for future residents.

Its proximity to education facilities, sporting complexes and the Greenwood Train Station will also be an attractor for people looking to live in the rapidly developing northern corridor.

Today’s sod turning signals the start of work to create a sales centre for the development at the south east corner of the site, with civil works to follow early in the New Year.
